1.2 Permitted wastes

Permitted categories and types of waste

1.2.1 No wastes other than those, which are categorised below in Table 1.2A and specified in detail in Appendix A to these conditions shall be accepted at the site.

Table 1.2A. Permitted quantities of waste	
Permitted Waste Categories	Maximum Permitted Quantities for each waste category (subject to maximum permitted total quantity in condition 1.2.2) (tonnes/year)
Construction and demolition wastes, including inert waste	No more than 2500 tonnes shall be stored at any one time, subject to maximum storage capacity detailed in Table 1.1
Waste Electronic and Electrical Equipment (WEEE) for recovery or reclamation	No more than 50 tonnes shall be stored at any one time, subject to maximum storage capacity detailed in Table 1.1
Plaster Board (non-hazardous)	No more than 500 tonnes shall be stored at any one time, subject to maximum storage capacity detailed in Table 1.1
Commercial and Industrial wastes (non-hazardous)	No more than 2500 tonnes shall be stored at any one time, subject to maximum storage capacity detailed in Table 1.1
Hazardous waste	No more than 10 tonnes of hazardous waste destined for disposal shall be stored at any one time, as detailed in Table 1.1
